The Breakthrough Montessori team will develop a cloud-based assessment platform through which teachers can review student progress and personalize instruction for each student's pace and learning style. The model will also make a significant investment in early childhood education, capitalizing on the formative period of brain development from birth to age six.

Breakthrough Montessori will join the National Center for Montessori in the Public Sector as a D.C. host site for the Montessori Teacher Residency, a program that focuses on job-embedded learning, along with ongoing mentoring and coaching for future teachers. Through this program, Breakthrough Montessori aims to standardize teacher training and increase the number of high-performing, high-impact Montessori schools in Washington, D.C.
